Abstracts should be limited to maximum two A4-size pages, including text, references, and possible figures and/or tables. Top, bottom, left, and right margins 25 mm.

- o **Title**: Upper and lower case, left justified, Times font, 14 pt bold.
- Contributors' names: Upper and lower case, left justified, first name first, surname last, Times font, 11 pt.
- Affiliation: Upper and lower case, left justified, Times font, 10 pt, italic. Numbered superscripts should be used to indicate the affiliation(s) of each contributor. E-mail address can be added in parentheses at the end of the corresponding contributor's affiliation.
- Main text: Single-spaced text, Times 10 pt font, no section headings.
